Michael is a former Deputy Police Commissioner who served with the NSW Police Force for over 31 years during which he led Area Commands and the Homicide Squad, the Counter Terrorism and Special Tactics Command, Central Metropolitan Region and Regional NSW Field Operations. He also led the state's recovery from the 2019/2022 bushfire disaster as 'State Recovery Coordinator.' He is currently moving into the private sector and has recently accepted an executive role in the National Security Area.



Detective Sergeant Mark Anthony Meredith, of Dubbo, was awarded the Medal (OAM) of the Order of Australia General Division.

The citation states: For service to the community through a range of organisations.

- LIVIN (Mental Health Education Program) Volunteer and Advocate, since 2016.
 - Macquarie Rugby League Football Club President, for many years,
 Vice President, for a number of years,
 Committee Person, for many years.
 - Dubbo Touch Football Association Player, for over 40 years, Referee, for over 20 years.
- New South Wales Police Force
 Detective Sergeant, since 2005,
 Detective Designation, 1999 2005,

 Police Officer, Orana Mid-Western Police District Dubbo, for over 30 years.

Mark has also previously been awarded the National Police Service Medal. 2014.

Mark obtained his HSC at Dubbo High School in 1982.

Alan Metcalf (Class of 65 cohort) was honoured recently by the Legislative Assemby of the NSW Parliament in a Community Recognition statement by Tim Crakanthorp MP.

Eleven years ago, aged 62, Alan set a world record by paddling from the Opera House to Queens Wharf Newcastle (137k) for children with cystic fibrosis.

Aged 73, he has just done it again Alan undertook a marathon paddle from Bondi Beach
to Newcastle Beach to raise funds for children
affected by DIPG, a rare form of childhood cancer.
He raised over \$10,000.
