

SPORTSWEAR

For safety reasons students must wear closed in leather shoes which completely cover their feet. Sandals do not provide sufficient protection. Students must wear the appropriate footwear to enter any of the practical work rooms or labs. On days when you have a practical PE lesson, you should bring your sports uniform to change into. After PE you will change back into your regular uniform.

What do I do if I don't have a uniform?

If for any reason you cannot wear your uniform please see your Year Adviser or Deputy Principal to assist with a solution.

General Information on Equipment
